Why Are There So Many Churches?

Intro:

1. It is a matter of authority - accepting it or rejecting it!

Body:

- I. Authority which is from heaven.
 - A. All authority is from God Gen. 1:1; Jn. 1:1-3.
 - 1. First through the prophets, then His Son Heb. 1:1-2.
 - 2. And finally through the apostles and prophets Jn. 17:8
 - a. They were guided Jn. 14:26; Jn. 16:13.
 - b. They wrote for our understanding Eph. 3:4-5.
 - c. His word was preserved 2 Pet. 3:15-16.
- II. Authority which is from man.
 - A. For example:
 - 1. Cain (different) Gen. 4:3-5; Heb. 11:4; Rom. 10:17.
 - 2. Nadab & Abihu (added) Lev. 10:1-2.
 - 3. Saul (rejected or eliminated) 1 Sam. 15:23.
 - B. These show men acting on his their own authority— Jer. 10:23; Prov. 14:12.
 - 1. The result of such Mk. 7:6-9; 2 Jn. 9; Rom. 6:23.
- III. Application to the question, "Why are there so many churches?"
 - A. The Bible authorizes one church Matt. 16:18; Acts 20:28; Eph. 1:22-23; Eph. 4:4.
 - 1. Therefore, not all churches are authorized by God.
 - B. For instance:
 - 1. We are to worship according to truth Jn. 4:23-24.
 - . God authorized singing Eph. 5:19; 2 Cor. 14:15.
 - 2. Immersion is authorized Rom. 6:3-4; Acts 8:38.
 - 3. The royal priesthood is authorized 1 Pet. 2:9.
 - a. The clergy system is not authorized Matt. 23:8-10; Gal. 3:28.
