 - D. David, before the throne was turned over to Solomon 1 Chron. 29:11-13.

 - A. The life of man is a gift from God Gen. 2:7.
 - 1. God is our Creator Eccl. 12:1; Ps. 100:3.
 - B. He has given Spiritual life 1 Jn. 4:9.
 - C. He is the giver of all things Jas. 1:17; 2 Cor. 9:8.
